8. VCBB updates: Chittenden County CUD reached out to us to help them understand why we went with a project manager instead of an Executive Director. They will probably go in a similar direction as us because the vast majority of that area is already connected.

9. Grants status: H360 and H315. A grant report is due on the 15<sup>th</sup> which Vantage Point will need to help us with. For the money from H360, our invoice was lost but Jackie has sorted this out and we should get a check within the next week.

10. Financials. Warrant: It is for \$994.40. Motion to approve the warrant by Larry. Seconded by Andrew. Motion passes.

10. Other Business: At the full board meeting we have some updates to the bylaws. Town Selectboards will need to reappoint board members.
